### **Focus on 5:18 – Filling of the Holy Spirit**

- “Be being filled” ⇒ a \_\_\_\_\_ action
- A \_\_\_\_\_ ⇒ requires a response
- A \_\_\_\_\_ ⇒ to be filled with the Spirit is to be \_\_\_\_\_ by the Spirit
- *How* can I be filled with the Holy Spirit? By \_\_\_\_\_ (Col. 2:6)
  - 1) Requires a \_\_\_\_\_ to be filled
  - 2) \_\_\_\_\_ / repent of any known \_\_\_\_\_ controlling my life
  - 3) Ask the Holy Spirit to fill / control me \_\_\_\_\_ :
    - Faith in God's \_\_\_\_\_ - Eph. 5:18
    - Faith in God's \_\_\_\_\_ - 1 Jn. 5:14-15
