 - A. John 3:1-8; Titus 3:5-6 - enable us to experience the new birth
 - B. Eph 1:13; 4:30; 2 Cor 1:22 - our seal from God that we are His
 - C. John 15:26; John 16:14 - to glorify Christ / make Him known
 - D. John 14:16-17; 15:26; 16:7 - to be our Helper / Counselor
 - E. John 16:8 - convict world of sin, righteousness, and judgment
 - F. John 16:13; 1 Corinthians 2:11,16 - to guide us to the truth
 - G. John 14:26 - to bring God's word to our remembrance
 - H. 1 Cor 12:13; Eph 1:13-14 - baptize believers into Christ's body
 - I. 1 Cor 12:11 - give gifts to believers to strengthen Christ's body
 - J. Romans 8:26 - to intercede for believers; help us to pray
 - K. Acts 1:8 - to give us power to witness for Christ
 - L. Galatians 5:22-23 - to produce Christ-likeness in the believer
 - M. Acts 15:28; 16:6 - to guide us into the will of God
 - N. Romans 5:5 - He is God's gift of love to us
 - O. Gal 5:16 - enable believers to resist the temptations of the flesh
 - P. Ephesians 5:18 and following - empowers believers to build up Christ's body
 - Q. Rom 8:2-11 - to be Christ in us; give us power to live in Christ
 - R. John 7:37-39 - to satisfy our spiritual thirst (in abundance!)
