- Two Journeys (12:1-3)

1) (vv. 4-9) – from Haran → \_\_\_\_\_ : \_\_\_\_\_  
*Shechem* *Bethel-Ai* *Negev*

2) (vv. 10-20) Negev → \_\_\_\_\_ : \_\_\_\_\_

- A. \_\_\_\_\_ to Pharaoh over Sarai
- B. \_\_\_\_\_ from Pharaoh (and great \_\_\_\_\_!)

### Lessons

- Abraham’s *obedience* and \_\_\_\_\_
- God’s \_\_\_\_\_ in Abram’s life
- When difficulties come, God may not want you to change \_\_\_\_\_
