The elders propose an amendment to the RBC Constitution for consideration at the quarterly business meeting on August 3, 2014. The amendment is in the form of an addition as Article II – Doctrine; Section 2. Doctrinal Statement; item (15) with proposed wording as follows.

Marriage and the Family – We believe that marriage was ordained by God at creation as the sacred union of one man and one woman. All sexual relations must therefore be reserved for that union. Christian marriage is to be a representation of Christ's relationship to His church. We also believe that children are a blessing from the Lord. Thus all human life is sacred and worthy of protection from the moment of conception.
