All of them, except for Joseph (and may be Reuben), had in common that they were \_\_\_\_\_ to the point of murder.

A similar case is found in Gen \_\_\_\_ where Cain killed Abel because of his jealousy!

There are some other major issues with Jacob's sons. Notice that the Bible exposes the sins of prominent figures in Israel's history.

\_\_\_\_\_ — Gen 38

Notice that the Lord chose to do two things for Jacob's sons through Joseph.

physical or spiritually?

physically or spiritually?

The Lord has chosen to do these same two things for you through Jesus Christ — Titus 3:1-7

- He chose to **save** you — Tit 3:4-6  
physical or spiritually?
- He chose to **use** them — Tit 3:1  
physically or spiritually?
