

## *Is Jesus God? (John 10:22-42)*

vv. 22-23 – The setting

- Feast of \_\_\_\_\_

v. 24 – Jews: *If You are \_\_\_\_\_, tell us plainly*

vv. 25-30 – Jesus' reply

The Jews (25-26): *You do not \_\_\_\_\_*

Jesus' sheep (27-28): *Those who \_\_\_\_\_ in Me*

- Hear My voice / I \_\_\_\_\_ them / They \_\_\_\_\_ Me
- I give \_\_\_\_\_ to them
- No one can \_\_\_\_\_ them away from Me

His Father (29-30): *Has \_\_\_\_\_ My sheep to Me*

vv. 31-33 – The Jews response: try to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus

vv. 34-36 – The \_\_\_\_\_ refutes their charge of blasphemy (Ps 82)

### ***Take-Away / Application***

1. Is Jesus God?

- Jesus *did* \_\_\_\_\_ to be God (v. 30; vv. 37-38)  
His opponents understood His claim – Jesus did not \_\_\_\_\_ them
- Jesus never \_\_\_\_\_ deity or stopped those who \_\_\_\_\_ Him (Jn. 9:35-38)
- Other Biblical claims that Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_ (Jn 1:1, 14; Col 2:8-10)
