

### ***Amnon's Wrong (2 Samuel 13:1-22)***

**v. 1** – Amnon and Absalom (half-brothers) and Tamar – sister of \_\_\_\_\_

**vv. 2-6** – Amnon \_\_\_\_\_ Tamar = a strong \_\_\_\_\_ desire (lust)

- Became ill ⇒ controlled by his \_\_\_\_\_ (2) (Lev. 18:11; 20:17)
- Accepted evil \_\_\_\_\_ of Jonadab (3-6) (Jas. 3:15)

**vv. 7-14** – Tamar obeyed and went to Amnon

- Amnon took hold of \_\_\_\_\_ to force her (11)
- Tamar \_\_\_\_\_ (12-13) – No: it would be to my \_\_\_\_\_ and yours
- Amnon would not listen and \_\_\_\_\_ Tamar by force

**vv. 15-19** – Amnon *hated* Tamar and sent her \_\_\_\_\_

- Tamar objected – a \_\_\_\_\_ wrong; left in shock and \_\_\_\_\_

**vv. 20-22** – Immediate aftermath: Absalom \_\_\_\_\_ for his sister

- David's \_\_\_\_\_ and Absalom's hatred

### ***Take-Away***

1. \_\_\_\_\_ sin in David's family (Ex. 34:7; Gal. 6:7-9)

- David → Amnon – could not \_\_\_\_\_ their sensual passions
- We will \_\_\_\_\_ what we \_\_\_\_\_
- God \_\_\_\_\_ sin (Ps. 51; 32) but does not remove \_\_\_\_\_
- The grace of God  
Eph. 2:1-9 – \_\_\_\_\_ us from our sins
